Editorial





- Services for doctoral students
- Support for student activities, such as the HGSFP Winter School and the cold quantum coffee seminar.
- Support for doctoral students to attend summer or winter schools elsewhere.
- Financial support for exchange visits to other institutes worldwide.
- Supports and organises the biannual Heidelberg Physics Graduate Days.
- Special aid is offered for initiatives that support gender equality.

- General benefits for both doctoral students and research staff
- A comprehensive visitors programme; a general colloquium plus individual colloquia in each branch of the HGSFP are funded.
- Bridging funds are available for doctoral students if necessary.
- Funding of workshops that will benefit doctoral students.
- Special ad-hoc lecture series as needed.
- Increased teaching and research capacity through junior research group leaders. ◀
